Regardless of address, every Iowan lives near a National Park Service site and can join the rest of the country April 18–26 to salute our own national wonders. Effigy Mounds National Monument in northeast Iowa offers a glimpse of Iowa's ancient peoples. The Herbert Hoover National Historic Site in West Branch includes President Hoover's two-room childhood home as well as exhibits of his White House years and final resting place. Southern Iowa includes many stops along the Mormon Pioneer National Historic Trail, which also traverses 10 other states. Western Iowa boasts the Lewis & Clark National Historic Trail. — C.B.
